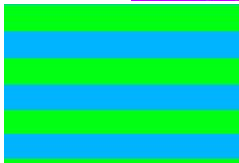
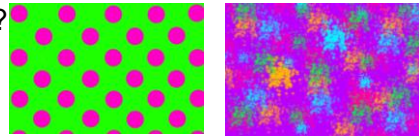
If we were to change the colors to something different what color would you choose?

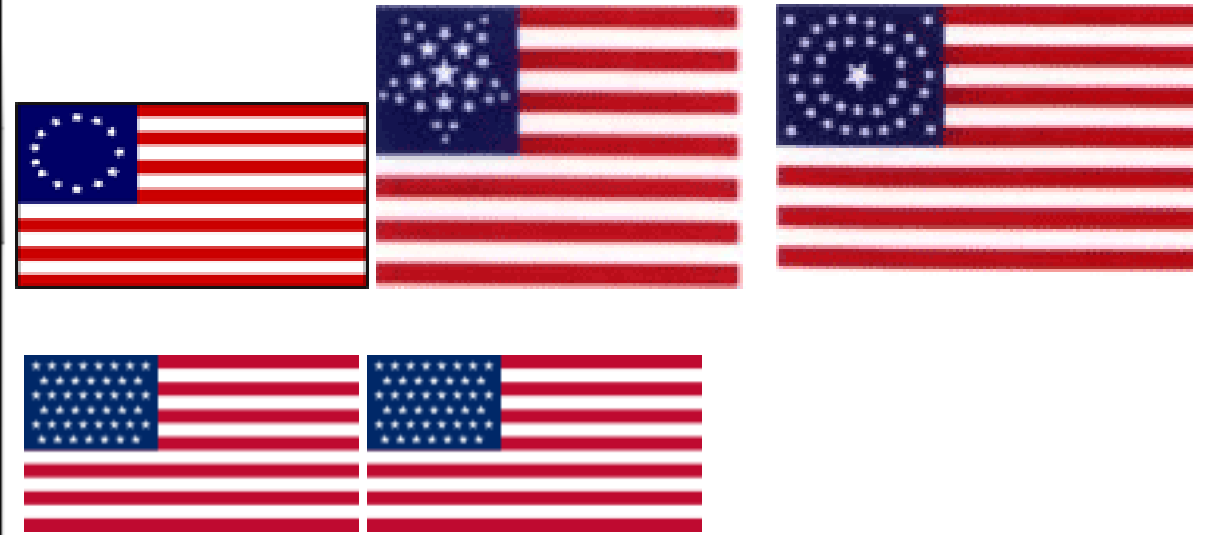
