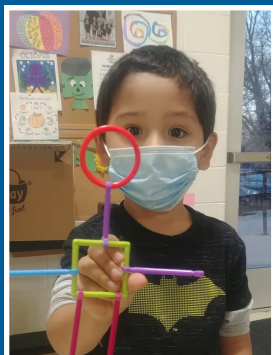
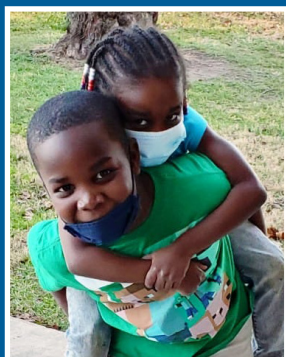
The All Stars Basketball season was cut short, but teams were able to play a few games and learn about basketball fundamentals.

All Club Sites close due to school shutdown

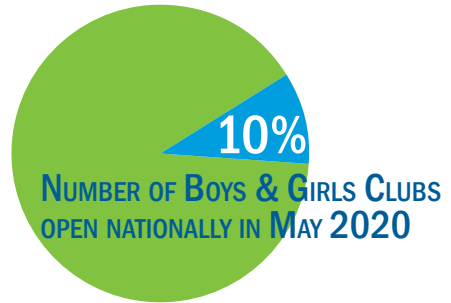
Staff immediately pivoted to virtual programming, checking on member families through letters and texts and volunteering with the Sedalia 200 School District to help pack meals for students.

In an effort to help Club families, especially working parents, and give members some sense of normalcy, Boys & Girls Club opened its Summer Program two weeks earlier than scheduled.



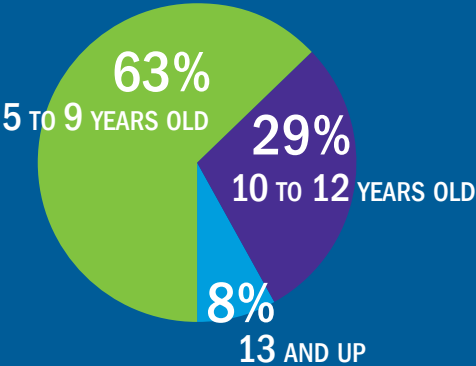

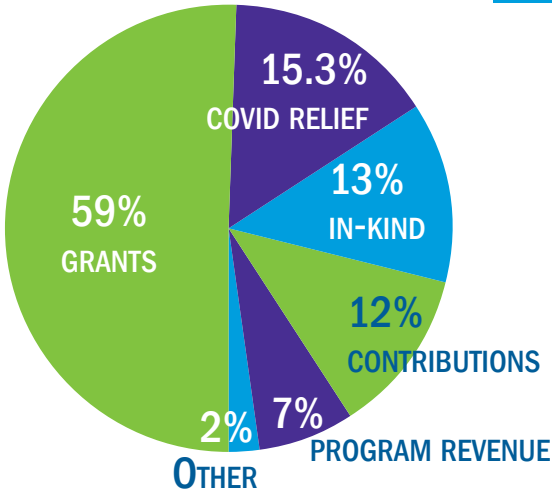

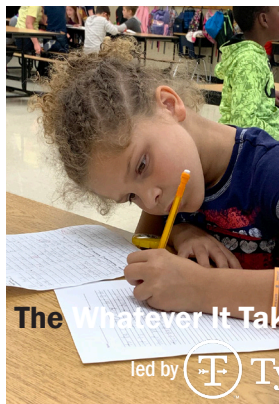
2020 WHATEVER IT TAKES CAMPAIGN

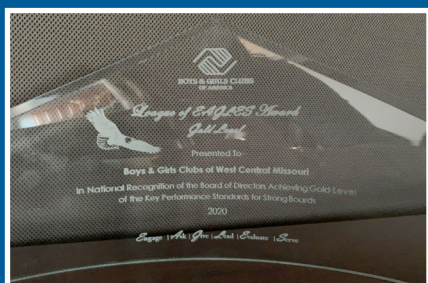

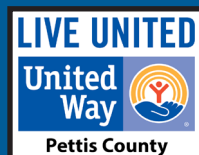


LEAGUE OF EAGLES AWARD
