


A Note From Executive Director, Gary Beckman



It is so nice to see things beginning to make their way back to pre-COVID times. Our Summer Program attendance numbers are well above what we've seen in recent years - during the first week we saw two days of 275+ kids in attendance. Compare that to 2019 numbers, seeing 180 kids on average, and we are the place for kids to be this summer! Thank you to our entire community for helping to provide a safe place for our kiddos during this pandemic, especially this summer. It truly has taken

everyone to withstand the struggles to stay open, to operate in a safe environment, and to keep our youth growing in their development.

In discussions with some of our area educators, we learned that our students' reading levels took a big hit during last year. Reading is the foundation to learning and strengthening one's educational experience, so in an effort to curb summer learning loss this year and help with reading levels, we implemented a reading program allowing for 30 minutes of specific reading time each morning and afternoon.

We also understand that not all kids can attend our Summer Program, so we started a new program to get books into all kids' hands, not just BGC members. This year we are focusing on Sedalia, with the goal to branch out into our surrounding communities to compliment the great work the Boonslick Regional Library Bookmobile Program does. During the first week, more than 350 books were given to children ranging in age from birth to 10-years-old.

It's been an incredible start to the summer and we can't wait to see how these new programs help develop our local youth for a successful future.
